
With your GrowthZone software you have the opportunity to display multiple directories on your public website, and within the Info Hub



Type Matters...


- Contact available to assign to both individuals and businesses

Getting Started - Directory Display Setting

Considerations...

- Do you wish to offer different listing levels?
- Do you want to set the display priority for members?
- What contact information do you want to display for your members?
- Do you wish to display member custom fields?
- For businesses, do you wish to display the business staff members on the listing?
- Which Options do you wish to include in the listing? Photos, logos, videos, etc.



Directory Display Settings

Priority Ranking...


A benefit that can be included in a directory listing is where the members is displayed in the directory. Setting the priority ranking on a listing will place members either higher or lower in a category. The lower the number the higher the priority placement of a member



Directory Display Settings

What contact information do you want to display for your members?

IMPORTANT: When choosing addresses, phone, email, website you must indicate the "type" AND when you enter this contact information for a contact, indicate the appropriate type






Directory Display Setting

Custom fields must be designated as Public to be displayed in the list of available fields



For Example:


If you are a Realtor Association you may with to have a directory for your Realtors and a second directory highlighting your Affiliates

Directories can be assigned automatically to your members by tying directories to memberships



Update Directory Information


- From the back office you have the ability to add/update directory information for your members
